Now I ask the students to take out the anticipation guide we started yesterday for the story Tops & Bottoms. I pull up our Folktales Interactive Whiteboard Lesson file and put on the Day 1 slide. I ask students to share with me their predictions of the five parts of the folktale (trickster, fool, problem, solution, lesson).
